



• APPLICATION PERIOD: Feb 15 - Mar 15, 2022

• EXAM DATE: Saturday, Mar 26, 2022

Possesses a minimum of 3-year working experience.





- Online application form: Fill in the application form via www.grad.chula.ac.th, then print out and submit along with other documents.
- One photocopy of identification card or passport
- Official academic transcripts
- One copy of English proficiency test: CU-TEP, IELTS or TOEFL. Valid within 2 years
- One copy of Business and Mathematics test: CU-Best, GMAT or GRE. Valid within 2 years
- Two letters of recommendation from different persons
- Certificate of employments covering 3-year period until present
- Statement of Interest
- Proposal Statement (2,000-2,500 words in English)
- Proof of payment

### REMARKS



Those who have no relevant experience in Logistics or Supply Chain must attend some courses provided in the Master program.

Recommendation letters must be referred by applicant's lecturers or supervisor. Recommendation letter by family members is not allowed.

Applicants must submit all required documents by the deadline of the application period, except the official test scores can be submitted on the day of the interview.





# Procedure for Student Visa Application and Visa Extension for International Students





Receive the Letter of Acceptance from CU



#### Documents required:

- Acceptance Package from CU (Letter of Acceptance
- + Certificate of Admission)
- Documents as required by the Royal Thai Embassy/ Consulate-General



Apply for a
Non-Immigrant
Visa to Thailand
(Use code "ED")



Receive a
90-day Stamp
on a passport upon
arrival at the airport



approx. 1 month



Up to the maximum of one year (from the permitted date given by the Immigration Officer), or until the graduation / course completion date.





Receive Visa Extension





to also apply for a re-entry permit at this stage.

Students who plan to travel outside Thailand during the initial 90-day permit must contact the program coordinators.



Apply for Visa
Extension
(Dress code required)



Within 45 days before the expiration date at the office of the Immigration Bureau, Government Center B Chaengwattana, Bangkok.
